Dear Parents,

Here are the scheduled field trips and events for the school year! We think it looks extra fun and inviting. New Policy: Parents need to drive their own child, stay at each field trip and buy the parent/sibling tickets at the door or use your family membership. Not all memberships cover the classes, but cover the entry fee. All Child Priority children will have pre-paid tickets. Children attend each field trip only once. If your child attended a field trip on the first day, they will remain at school with several other kids and a teacher for a regular school day, 9-1pm. Usually this consists of about 10-12 kids staying. Thanks so much!

Anderson Farms – Sept. 29 & 30 (Thursday & Friday) 9 am – 12:30pm

Arrive at the farm at 9:00 am Directions & schedule will be emailed several days prior to field trip
Our fun-filled autumn day will begin with a 9:15 am class about growing vegetables starting from seeds, then a hayride to the pumpkin field to choose a pumpkin. We will return for washing hands and an early lunch. Then you can explore all the play areas and visit with real animals and go on a free ride on the Mine Cars!
Adults and Siblings, 2 years and older need to purchase their own tickets at the gate.

Children’s Museum February 14 & 15 (Tuesday and Wednesday) 9:30-11:30am

Arrive at the museum by 9:15am. The museum opens at 9:30am.
“The Ginger Bread Man” Interactive theatre at its best! The kids will bring nursery rhymes and fairytales to life as they act out the adventures of this mischievous little cookie with scenery and costumes for a wonderful performance. This is an absolute favorite of schools at the Children’s Museum.
We will spend an additional 1:15 minutes having fun exploring the museum. Total field trip time 9:30-11:30am
All CPP kids pre-paid for and parents/siblings buy their own tickets at the door. Cost \$9-\$11 without a museum membership. Membership entrance may not include the “Ginger Bread Man” class.
We will head back to school at 11:30am for lunch, outside time and story.

Denver Museum Nature and Science April 13 & 14 (Thursday and Friday)

Dinosaur Detectives! Arrive at museum by 9:15am. Meet at school entrance on south side
Our adventure is from 9:30-12:30pm
We will become paleontologist in one of the state-of-the-art Exploration Studios, and uncover clues from the past in order to imagine what it was like when Colorado’s state fossil, Stegosaurus, roamed the land. 45 minute class
We will tour Prehistoric Journey Dinosaur and explore “Discovery Zone”.
We will have a sack lunch at the museum. Pack a lunch with a drink for you and your child. Please meet us at the museum at 9:15am and plan to head home from the museum by 12:30. Child Priority kids have pre-paid tickets. Families can use their membership for entrance into the museum, but it may not cover the Dinosaur Detectives class.
