Here are the scheduled field trips and events for the school year! We think it looks extra fun and inviting. New Policy: Parents need to drive their own child, stay at each field trip and buy the parent/sibling tickets at the door or use your family membership. Not all memberships cover the classes, but cover the entry fee. All Child Priority children will have pre-paid tickets. Children attend each field trip only once. Thanks so much!

Anderson Farms – Sept. 29 & 30 (Thursday & Friday)

Arrive at the farm at 9:15am Leave for home from the farm by 12:30pm.

Directions & schedule will be emailed several days prior to our field trip.

Our fun-filled autumn day will begin at 9:30am with a class about growing vegetables starting from seeds, then a hayride to the pumpkin field to choose a pumpkin. We will return for washing hands and an early lunch. Then you can explore all the play areas and visit with real animals and go on a free ride on the Mine Cars!

Childrens Museum “The Bubble Lab” Feb. 21 & 22 (Tuesday & Wednesday)

Arrive at the museum by 9:15am. Museum opens at 9:30 and class begins. Young scientists will learn about bubbles and their amazing properties. Using bubble-making ingredients discover the science secrets behind bubbles with shimmering, floating, popping play! Bubble Lab class does not take place in the Bubbles exhibit. We will spend an additional 1:15 minutes having fun exploring the museum. Total field trip time 9:30-11:30am Cost \$9-\$11 without a museum membership. All CPP kids pre-paid for and parents/siblings buy their own tickets at the door. We will head back to school at 11:30am for lunch, outside time and story.

Denver Museum of Nature and Science – April 20 & 21 (Thursday and Friday)

“The Bear Necessities” class 9:30-12:30pm

Arrive at Museum by 9:15 am Meet at the school entrance on the south side. CPP kids are prepaid

Parents & siblings pay at door. Museum memberships may not cover the “Bear Necessities” class.

Our adventure will include an educational class entitled: “The Bear Necessities!” Kids can become a black bear cub and learn from the mama bear how to walk, eat, and sniff like a bear using dramatic play and hands-on activities. Don't fall asleep for the most important part: how black bears survive the freezing cold winter. We will also tour the wild life exhibit, visit the discovery zone and have a sack lunch at the museum. Pack a lunch with a drink for you and your child. Please meet us at the museum at 9:15am and plan to head home from the museum by 12:30 pm.
